#### An Adventure on the Water

The Yasawa Princess cruises through the central atolls of the Maldives – including South Malé, Vaavu, and Ari – bringing you to spectacular underwater worlds that delight both snorkelers and divers. Highlights of the itinerary include a famous night snorkelling experience at Alimathaa with nurse sharks and stingrays, a whale shark safari at the southern edge of the Ari Atoll, and an optional manta ray excursion.

In addition to the underwater experiences, you'll enjoy dreamlike stops on both inhabited and uninhabited islands, as well as on pristine sandbanks – ideal for relaxing, exploring, or photography. Departures take place every Monday. The standard cruise lasts 14 nights. Guests who prefer a one-week option can depart after 7 nights with a domestic flight between Malé and Maamigili (or vice versa, depending on the schedule).



## **Travel Itinerary (excerpt)**

#### Day 1 (Monday)

Arrival in Malé and transfer to the Yasawa Princess. Welcome briefing and introduction to the crew, guests, and safety procedures. Dinner and overnight onboard. (L, D)

#### Day 2-8 (Tuesday–Monday)

Cruise through South Malé, Vaavu, and South Ari Atolls. Daily snorkelling at world-class reefs, relaxing on sandbanks like Kalhuhuraa, Hathikolhu, and Alimatha, and visiting islands such as Dhigurah and Dhagenthi. Highlights include:

- Optional snorkelling at Dhiggiri Thila (with nurse sharks)
- Whale shark excursion (optional, USD 30 excl. tax)
- Sunset cocktails & BBQ evenings
- Visits to local islands and cultural encounters

For those booked on the 8-day cruise, return flight from or to Maamigili is scheduled on Day 8.



#### Day 9-15 (for 15-day cruise passengers)

Additional days include further sandbank experiences, manta ray excursions (USD 25 excl. tax), visits to islands like Hurasdhoo, Embudhoo, Alikoi Rah, Meerufenfushi, Maayafushi, and a return to Malé with city visit and optional aquarium tour. Departure on Day 15 after breakfast and transfer to Malé airport. **Übernachtung an Bord.** (*F*, *M*, *A*)





#### MV Yasawa Princess – Your Floating Hotel

The ship offers 28 twin or double cabins across three decks:

- Bridge Deck (7 cabins): ~10 m<sup>2</sup>, upper deck with large windows
- A-Deck (14 cabins): ~11 m<sup>2</sup>, main deck with large windows
- Lower Main Deck (7 cabins): ~13 m<sup>2</sup>, lower deck with portholes

All cabins include private bathroom with shower, adjustable air conditioning, and a mini-safe. Some cabins have an additional fan. Windows are fixed for safety reasons. The indoor restaurant and bar offer Wi-Fi (signal not always stable). Lounge areas are available indoors and outdoors, including a spacious sundeck with loungers and shaded areas.

## **Entry Requirements (for EU citizens)**

A passport valid at least 6 months beyond entry date is required. The passport must be in good condition and have sufficient blank pages. Entry form must be completed within 96 hours prior to departure: https://travel.immigration.gov.mv. No mandatory vaccinations; standard immunizations are recommended. COVID-19 restrictions are currently lifted (as of 04/2025), but this may change depending on the situation.

- Depending on flight schedules, a pre- or post-night hotel stay may be required and booked separately.
- Wi-Fi is available in the restaurant and bar but may be unstable.
- Flight prices are based on special tour operator fares; we're happy to provide flight options.
